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You Could Rock Out in Keith Richards's \$12.2 Million New York Penthouse

Inside a classic Art Deco building is this modern gem

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The Rolling Stones guitarist Keith Richards's NYC duplex penthouse on Fifth Avenue is a rock star's paradise, although you might not suspect it from the 1929 apartment building's Art Deco exterior. Renovated in 2011 by architect Joe Serrins, the unit features an airy contemporary design, according to [StreetEasy](#). On the main floor, beyond the gallery hall entrance, is a large living room with views of Greenwich Village, the master suite, a second en suite bedroom, a dining room, and a kitchen with a breakfast bar. There are also three [terraces](#) on this level to take in the New York skyline. An open [staircase](#), with a leather-wrapped bronze handrail, leads to two more en suite bedrooms separated by a large study on the second floor. The building amenities include a full-time doorman, laundry facilities, and extra storage space.
